FULL-TIME PUBLIC WORKS MECHANIC JOB POSTING

Job Overview: Under the direction of the Supervisor/Lead Mechanic, Superintendent, Foreman, and Assistant Foreman, the Mechanic performs maintenance and repairs on motor vehicles and mechanized equipment using machine and hand tools common to the trade. The role includes related duties as assigned and may require assisting with other responsibilities during emergencies or operational needs.

Job Responsibilities:

- Perform maintenance and repairs on municipal vehicles, equipment, and powered machinery, including gasoline and diesel engines.
- Diagnose mechanical problems using diagnostic equipment and standard troubleshooting methods.
- Verifies drivers' comments and/or road tests vehicles to determine causes of unusual engine noises and/or vibrations, unusual exhaust color, odor, or sound, or other indications of problems.
- Removes and installs radiators, water pumps, hoses, cooling fans, new and reconditioned engines and transmissions.
- Conduct preventive maintenance to ensure safe and reliable operation of municipal vehicles and equipment.
- Replace worn or defective parts and equipment, and complete routine servicing tasks.
- Maintain inventory and organization of parts, tools, and maintenance supplies.

Additional Requirements:

- A valid NJ CDL Class B with Air Brake endorsement Driver's License is required as well as knowledge and ability to operate Heavy vehicles and equipment, light duty dump trucks, pickups, snowplows, salt spreaders, power tools, chain saws, and hand tools, etc. The ability to understand and follow written and oral instructions and work independently is required.
- The candidate, if required, is expected to work in all types of weather conditions. Safety procedures and practices are required, as well as wearing safety equipment. The candidate must be available for emergencies 24/7 such as snowfall, floods, downed trees and any public safety related event.
- Applicants should have a High School Diploma. Knowledge of diesel engine repair, hydraulics, welding, fabrication, electrical systems and general vehicle maintenance is a plus.
- Tools must be supplied by the employee.
