

**Township of Mantua
Minutes
Meeting June 19, 2017
Mantua Township Municipal Building
6:00 P.M.**

On the above date the Township Committee of the Township of Mantua held its Regular Meeting in the Mantua Township Municipal Building, 401 Main Street, Mantua, New Jersey 08051.

Mayor Scirrotto called the meeting to order. The time was 6:00 p.m. Mayor Scirrotto asked everyone to rise for the Flag Salute and remain standing to observe a moment of silence.

Mayor Scirrotto delivered the Sunshine Notice as required by the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion to approve June 19, 2017 - Deputy Mayor Zimmerman, 2nd Committeeman Legge. Committeewoman Lukens abstained. 4 in favor

Public Participation

Gregory Shast – 39 Silvercreek Dr – Mr, Shast inquired as to why no one in the community is aware that there is a change in the Master Plan regarding zoning from AG to Residential. Mayor Scirrotto advised that this is something that goes before the Land Use Board at their meetings and that this committee is not in favor of any changes to the re-zoning. Administrator Bileci also advised Mr. Shast that this has to go before the Land Use Board and that they have a statutory obligation to have it heard at their meetings. Mr. Shast thanked them for the information as he was misinformed.

ORDINANCE O-10-2017: BOND ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF VARIOUS PIECES OF CAPITAL EQUIPMENT AND THE COMPLETION OF VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF MANTUA, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$815,000 THEREFOR; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OR BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANTUA, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY, IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF UP TO \$608,000; MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS AND COVENANTS; AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN RELATED ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE FOREGOING
