# DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

## TRASH PICK UP

- Trash containers must be curbside by 6 am on collection day and should not be placed at the curb before 6 pm on the day before your collection day.
- Trash containers must be removed from the curb by 7 pm on trash collection day. When your trash day falls on a holiday, trash will be collected as per the calendar.
- Only trash in provided **BLACK** carts will be collected.
- Trash must be placed in a bag & then placed in the provided trash cart.
- Containers should be less than 50 lbs.
- A street is **NOT** considered missed before 6 pm on your scheduled trash day.
- **Work by contractors will not be TAKEN!**

### WE DO NOT PICK UP THE FOLLOWING!

- Asphalt shingles
- Concrete, cinder blocks, bricks
- Tires
- Propane tanks
- Chemicals
- Rail road ties
- Fluorescent light bulbs

## PAINT DISPOSAL

- Latex (also called “water based”) paint can be placed for curbside pickup under these guidelines:

- Lid off
- Cans filled with clay-based kitty litter or speedy dry
- Completely dried out
- Do not put the lid back on the paint can



## LEAF COLLECTION

- Starting November 1st – December 30th leaves are picked up the day before your trash day.
- Please keep leaves bag free and away from storm drain inlets and parked cars.
- Leaves can be raked to the curb. Leaves in bags will not be picked up.
- Leaves must be free of brush or wood.
- **DO NOT PLACE BRUSH ON TOP OF LEAF PILES**
- Spring leaf pickup is one week only April 17, 2023 - April 21, 2023.

## BRANCHES & BRUSH

- Brush will be collected by the brush crane on non-bulk weeks on your trash day.
- **NO STUMPS**

## GRASS/VEGETATIVE WASTE

- Disposal of Grass and Vegetative Waste is to be placed inside the **GREEN** cart. This pickup is from March 20, 2023 – October 27, 2023.

### ONLY GRASS AND LEAVES IN THE GREEN CART!

**NO dirt, mulch, branches or sticks.**



## BULK ITEMS

- Bulk Trash is for residential household waste ONLY. First full week of every month Monday - Friday **“ONLY”** on your trash day!
- **DO NOT PLACE YOUR BULK OUT** before 6:00 pm the day before your collection.
- This refers to waste that is generated by the residents of the household.
- This **DOES NOT** include the structure and/or the outside structure, storm damage, remodeling or ANY kind or any construction debris.
- **CARPET** can be placed curbside in 4 ft lengths, tied and bundled.
- Old furniture may be placed at the curb with your trash, as well as white goods, such as a refrigerator, air conditioner, washer, or dryer or light iron.
- Doors must be removed from appliances before they are placed at the curb.
- We reserve the right to reject excessive bulk loads or any materials not accepted.
- E-WASTE TV's, computers, DVD's, CD players, etc. must go out during the bulk week.

## CONVEINCE CENTER DROP-OFF

### Public Works Facility Garage (407 Main Street)

Located behind the Police Department

Hours: **10 am - 2 pm** on the 4th Saturday of the month & every Saturday in June, July and August.

We accept the following **HOUSEHOLD** items for disposal.

- Used Motor Oil
- Household Bulk Items
- Yard Waste (brush, leaves, grass)
- Electronics (TV's and computers)
- Metal Items (light iron, refrigerators, BBQ grills and A/C units)
- Contractors will be turned away.

**Proof of residency is required!**



## HAZARDOUS WASTE

The Township will not pick up any hazardous or combustible waste. Any product which is labeled “warning, caution, poisonous, toxic, flammable, corrosive, reactive or explosive” is considered hazardous waste. This includes household products containing toxic chemicals, ammunition, paint, pesticides, herbicides, turpentine, lighter fluid, photographic and pool chemicals, rat poisons, car batteries and other hazardous materials. Gloucester County sponsors six “Household Special Waste” Collection days each year. These items may be taken to the County for proper disposal at those times.

# RECYCLING & DISPOSAL

## PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

### NEW CARDBOARD RECYCLING RULES

We are finding hazardous materials hidden in cardboard boxes that residents set out for recycling.

For this reason, **CARDBOARD BOXES MUST BE FLATTENED AND EMPTIED BEFORE RECYCLING.**

Fold large boxes, like appliance boxes.

Do not use boxes to hold other recyclables.

Remove and throw away foam and plastic wrap.

- Do not recycle Amazon plastic mailers.

## Project Medicine Drop

The Police Department participates in "Project Medicine Drop," a program where "prescription drug boxes" are installed at participating New Jersey Police departments. Resident or non-residents can safely, securely, and anonymously drop off unused and/or expired medications through our lobbies' ground-mounted, locked metal mailbox with the "project medicine drop" logo. While this service is available all 365 days of the year, a dispatcher must be contacted through our red phone in the lobby to have an officer let you in after 4:30PM on weekdays and all weekends/holidays.

## Project Safe Deal Zone

When conducting a face to face sales transaction through online services such as Craigslist or Facebook Marketplace, the Police Department offers 24 hour well-lit surveillance zones for your protection. Officers will be available via dispatch at 856-468-1920 for added security.

# OUR PARKS

## **CHESTNUT BRANCH PARK 545 Main Street**

Named for the Chestnut Branch of the Mantua Creek, Chestnut Branch Park is more than 109 acres and includes athletic fields and facilities and two wooded areas of rolling hills with scenic trails and diverse wildlife. Along the edge of the fields, there are some wetlands that attract grassland birds as well as woodland species. A paved path circles the athletic fields, and bicyclists and walkers make use of this pathway. Follow the path to the right from the parking lot to get to the Butterfly Garden. The best time for viewing is mid-day in the summer. Continue on the path and you arrive at the 9/11 Memorial Place of Reflection with benches within a landscaped grove. ## **CERES PARK 403 Pitman Road / 940 Main Street**

Ceres Park is a beautiful landscape of natural growth, hosting a thriving community of animal life that includes mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and many bird species. With an extensive trail system through upland and wetland forests, the preserve can seem much bigger than 52 acres. From the parking lot, a mile-long path through the forest is crisscrossed by many less-defined trails. The trails lead through a diverse selection of plant life to beautiful views of Emerald and Cedar Lakes. Walking/jogging/biking trails lead to the Chestnut Branch of Mantua Creek and through adjacent county-owned lands, allowing visitors to explore beyond the boundaries of the park. ## **MCCARSON PARK Corner of Mercer Ave and Mantua Blvd.**

## PATRIOT DAY CEREMONY

The Gloucester County Patriot Day Ceremony is our way to continue to remember the September 11th attacks.

The memorial service is a tribute to Gloucester County residents John Rodak, Nicholas W. Brandemarti, and Perry Thompson who lost their lives during the attacks on Sept. 11, 2001.

The ceremony begins at 8:30 A.M. at the Place of Reflection at Chestnut Branch Park located on Main Street in Mantua. The ceremony will include a bell ringing to coincide with the timing of the events, and a wreath-laying at the county's 9/11 Memorial - a twisted I-beam from the World Trade Center.

Our peaceful, 9/11 Memorial is a place to reflect and dedicate time to remember the fallen victims of the 9/11 attack. The Place of Reflection also includes a tribute of remembrance of those who lost their lives at the Pentagon. The Pentagon Memorial Site Enhancement Project includes a sitting wall in the shape of the Pentagon (18 inches tall) as well as a piece of block from a wall of the Pentagon placed at a distance of 9 ft. 11 in. behind the flag pole. There are 184 grey border pavers that outline the pentagon which represent the 184 lives that were lost at the Pentagon site.

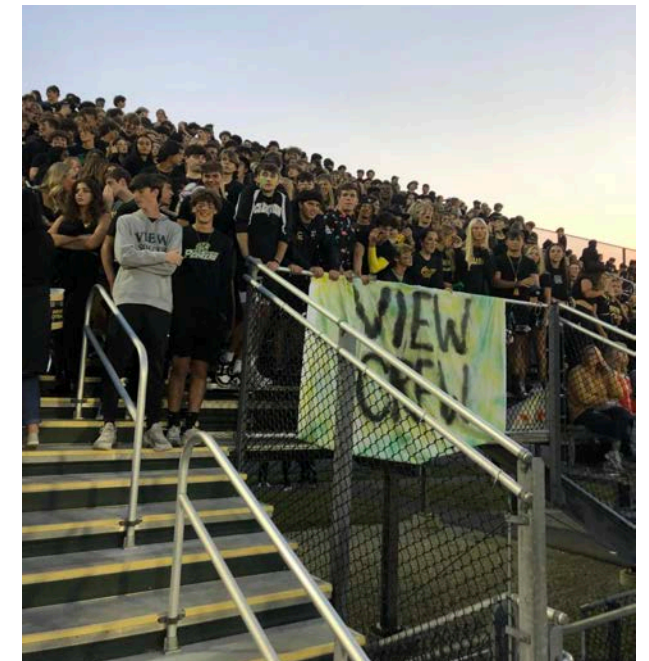
