FEBRUARY 2024

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

TRASH PICK UP

- Trash containers must be curbside by 6 am on the collection day and should not be placed at the curb before 6 pm on the day before your collection day.
- Trash containers must be removed from the curb by 7 pm on trash collection day.
- When your trash day falls on a holiday, trash will be collected as per the calendar.
- Only trash in provided BLACK carts will be collected.
- Trash must be placed in a bag and then put in the provided trash cart.
- Containers should weigh less than 50 lbs.
- A street is NOT considered missed before 6 pm on your scheduled trash day.
- Work by contractors will not be accepted!

WE DO NOT PICK UP THE FOLLOWING:

- Asphalt
- Shingles
- Concrete, Cinder Blocks, BricksTires



HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Mantua Township will not collect hazardous or combustible waste.
- Hazardous waste is labeled with terms like "warning, caution, poisonous, toxic, flammable, corrosive, reactive, or explosive."
- Toxic chemicals, ammunition, paint, pesticides, herbicides, turpentine, lighter fluid, photographic and pool chemicals, rat poisons, and car batteries, are considered hazardous.
- Gloucester County holds six "Household Special Waste" collection days annually, where residents can dispose of these items.

PAINT DISPOSAL



- Latex paint, also known as "waterbased" paint, can be placed for curbside pickup **following these guidelines:**
- Leave the lid off.
- Fill cans with clay-based kitty litter or speedy dry.
- Ensure the paint is completely dried out.
- Do not put the paint can lid back on.

LEAF COLLECTION

- Starting October 28, 2024, leaves are picked up the day before your trash day.
- Leaves should be bag-free and kept away from storm drains, inlets, and parked cars.
- Rake leaves to the curb; leaves in bags will not be picked up.
- Ensure leaves are free of brush or wood.
- DO NOT PLACE BRUSH ON TOP OF LEAF PILES.
- Spring leaf pickup is scheduled for one week only, from April 15, 2024, to April 19, 2024.

BRANCHES & BRUSH

- Brush will be collected by the brush crane on non-bulk weeks, on your trash day.
- NO STUMPS.

GRASS/VEGETATIVE WASTE

- Disposal of grass and vegetative waste is to be placed inside the **GREEN** cart.
- Pick up is from March 18, 2024, to October 25, 2024
- Only grass and leaves are permitted in the green cart.
- NO dirt, mulch, branches, or sticks.

BULK WEEK

- Bulk trash is for residential household waste ONLY during the first full week of every month on your designated trash day.
- DO NOT PLACE YOUR BULK OUT before 6:00 pm on the day preceding your collection.
- Bulk trash pertains to waste generated by household residents and DOES NOT include the waste from interior structures, exterior structures, storm damage, remodeling, or ANY type of construction debris.
- CARPET can be placed curbside in 4 ft lengths, tied, and bundled.
- Old furniture, as well as white goods such as refrigerators, air conditioners, washers, dryers, and light iron, may be placed at the curb as bulk trash. **Doors must be removed from appliances before placing them at the curb.**
- We reserve the right to reject excessive bulk loads, or any materials not accepted.
- E-WASTE, including TVs, computers, DVD players, CD players, etc., must be placed out during the designated bulk week.

Project Safe Deal Zone

When conducting a face-to-face sales transaction through online services, such as Craigslist or Facebook Marketplace, the Police Department offers 24-hour well-lit surveillance zones for your protection. Officers will be available via dispatch at 856-468-1920 for added security.

Special Needs Registry

The special needs registry delivers valuable information to assist the Police Department to locate and provide for those who suffer with special needs or other disabilities. The packet can be located under the Police Department section of our website.

Traffic Safety

The Police Department encourages residents to report traffic-related safety issues to the Traffic Safety Unit by emailing mantuapd@mantuatownship.com.

Project Medicine Drop

The Police Department participates in "Project Medicine Drop," a program where "prescription drug boxes" are installed at participating New Jersey Police departments. Resident or non-residents can safely, securely, and anonymously drop off unused and/or expired medications through our lobbies' ground-mounted, locked metal mailbox with the "project medicine drop" logo. While this service is available all 365 days of the year, a dispatcher must be contacted through our red phone in the lobby to have an officer let you in after 4:30 p.m. on weekdays, weekends, and holidays.

Straight To Treatment

Those battling with an addiction are encouraged to speak with a Police Department representative. To identify treatment solutions, a service provider can be reached inperson on Thursday from 3-6 p.m. or at 856-766-8870.

Gloucester County Notification

OUR PARKS

CHESTNUT BRANCH PARK: 545 Main Street

Named after the Chestnut Branch of Mantua Creek, Chestnut Branch Park offers over 109 acres of beautifully maintained landscapes and facilities. The park includes athletic fields, a newly constructed disc golf course, two wooded areas with rolling hills, scenic trails, and a diverse wildlife population. The fields and surrounding wetlands attract a range of grassland and woodland birds. A paved pathway encircles the athletic fields, providing a perfect spot for biking and walking. Continue along the path, and you'll arrive at the 9/11 Memorial Place of Reflection, a serene spot with landscaped groves and benches. CERES PARK: 403 Pitman Road / 940 Main Street

Ceres Park is a beautiful landscape of natural growth, hosting a thriving community of animal life that includes mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and many bird species. With an extensive trail system through upland and wetland forests, the preserve appears much bigger than 52 acres. From the parking lot, a one-mile path leads through the forest, crisscrossed by several other trails. These trails meander through a wide variety of plant life, offering breathtaking views of Emerald and Cedar Lakes. Additionally, the park's walking, jogging, and biking trails continue past the Chestnut Branch of Mantua Creek and into adjacent county-owned lands, providing an opportunity for visitors to explore beyond the park's borders. MCCARSON PARK: Corner of Mercer Ave and Mantua Blvd.

Formerly known as Sewell Playground, this park and playground now serves as a tribute to the late Trooper Eli McCarson. The addition of a memorial plaque and a paver triangle, which replicates a Trooper's badge, makes this park a truly special place.

Patriot Day Ceremony

The Gloucester County Patriot Day Ceremony is our way to continue to remember the September 11th attacks.

The memorial service is a tribute to Gloucester County residents John Rodak, Nicholas W. Brandemarti, and Perry Thompson, who lost their lives during the attacks on September 11, 2001.

The ceremony begins at 8:30 a.m. at the Place of Reflection at Chestnut Branch Park, located on Main Street in Mantua. The ceremony will include a bell ringing to coincide with the timing of the events and a wreath-laying at the county's 9/11 Memorial - a twisted I-beam from the World Trade Center.

Our peaceful 9/11 Memorial is a place to reflect and dedicate time to remember the fallen victims of the 9/11 attacks. The Place of Reflection also includes a tribute of remembrance of those who lost their lives at the Pentagon. The Pentagon Memorial Site Enhancement Project features a sitting wall in the shape of the Pentagon (18 inches tall) and a piece of block from a wall of the Pentagon placed at a distance of 9 ft. 11 in. behind the flag pole. Additionally, 184 grey border pavers outline the Pentagon, which represents the 184 lives that were lost at the Pentagon site.
