SENIOR CITIZEN – PROPERTY TAX DEDUCTION

1. Proof of Age: Birth Certificate, Driver's License or State Identification Card
2. Proof of Residence in NJ: Driver's License, Motor Vehicle Registration or Voter's Registration
3. Proof of Income: Complete and Sign the attached Supplemental Income Form*

***Must provide proof of each type of income reported, i.e.: SS Letter, Federal Tax Return, Bank Statement, etc.**

DISABLED PERSON – PROPERTY TAX DEDUCTION

1. Proof of Disability: Physician's Certificate, Social Security Document or NJ Commission for Blind Certificate
2. Proof of Residence in NJ: Driver's License, Motor Vehicle Registration or Voter's Registration
3. Proof of Income: Complete and Sign the attached Supplemental Income Form*

***Must provide proof of each type of income reported, i.e.: SS Letter, Federal Tax Return, Bank Statement, etc.**

SURVIVING SPOUSE OF SENIOR CITIZEN OR DISABLED PERSON – PROPERTY TAX DEDUCTION

1. Proof of Decedent's Disability: Physician's Certificate, Social Security Document or NJ Commission for Blind Certificate
2. Proof of Age: Birth Certificate, Driver's License or State Identification Card (Must be 55 or older)
3. Proof of Residence in NJ: Driver's License, Motor Vehicle Registration or Voter's Registration
4. Proof of Income: Complete and Sign the attached Supplemental Income Form*

***Must provide proof of each type of income reported, i.e.: SS Letter, Federal Tax Return, Bank Statement, etc.**

5. Decedent's Death Certificate
6. Marriage Certificate

VETERAN OR SURVIVING SPOUSE OF VETERAN – PROPERTY TAX DEDUCTION

1. Proof of Military Service: Certificate of Honorable Discharge or Release – DD Form 214
2. Proof of Residence in NJ: Driver's License, Motor Vehicle Registration or Voter's Registration
3. For Surviving Spouse Application: Decedent's Death Certificate
4. For Surviving Spouse Application: Marriage Certificate

DISABLED VETERAN – PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION

1. Proof of Military Service: Certificate of Honorable Discharge or Release – DD Form 214
2. Proof of Residence in NJ: Driver's License, Motor Vehicle Registration or Voter's Registration
3. Department of Veteran's Affairs Certification of **100% Totally & Permanently Disabled** (See samples)

SURVIVING SPOUSE OF DISABLED VETERAN – PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION

1. Proof of Military Service: Certificate of Honorable Discharge or Release – DD Form 214
2. Proof of Residence in NJ: Driver's License, Motor Vehicle Registration or Voter's Registration
3. Department of Veteran's Affairs Certification of **100% Totally & Permanently Disabled** (See samples)
4. Decedent's Death Certificate
5. Marriage Certificate
